How Does the Program Work?

Innovations Academy is a non-traditional, blended learning environment. It is a hybrid program that blends on-line learning with classroom group participation. Each student is given an on-line lesson plan to accomplish at home. In addition, each student is expected to attend class one day a week at Innovations Academy for 3 hours. The face to face sessions provide opportunities for collaboration and socialization. Additionally, students are invited to attend tutoring sessions to receive additional support. Each student will be guided by a Learning Coach (parent or other adult chosen by the parent) to complete all on-line assignments. Assessments which include quizzes, tests, and portfolios, are assigned daily.

The Learning Coach is the adult who performs tasks such as reviewing lessons, providing supervision, and communicating with teachers.
